DIRECT EXPOSURE MEANS:
A staff member who is within 3 feet for longer than 15 minutes of someone who is positive for COVID-19.

- COVID SYMPTOMS**
- Fever greater than or equal to 100.0
 - Cough
 - Loss of Taste or Smell
 - Shortness of Breath
 - Difficulty Breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Headache
 - Chills
 - Sore Throat
 - Congestion or Runny Nose
 - Shaking or Exaggerated Shivering
 - Significant Muscle or Body Aches
 - Nausea or Vomiting
 - Diarrhea

Fully Vaccinated staff may continue to come to school after direct exposure. Staff members should monitor for any development of COVID-19 related symptoms after direct exposure.

Staff Members **NOT** Fully Vaccinated who meet direct exposure threshold are recommended to self-isolate at home for a 5-day period.

Staff members who continue to work on campus after direct exposure must be rapid tested at the start of the day, at least once every other day until the end of day 5.

Quarantine recommendations after a school exposure

If you are exposed to someone at school who tests positive for COVID-19, you can continue to come to school if:

You are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (2 weeks after your final dose), or

You and the person who tested positive were both wearing masks, or

You have tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days, or

You were wearing a N95 or KN95 mask, even if the person who tested positive was not wearing a mask.
