



# Granbury ISD COVID-19 Direct Exposure Flow Sheet



Direct Exposure to someone testing Positive for COVID -19

- COVID SYMPTOMS**
- Fever greater than or equal to 100.0
  - Cough
  - Loss of Taste or Smell
  - Shortness of Breath
  - Difficulty Breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Headache
  - Chills
  - Sore Throat
  - Congestion or Runny Nose
  - Shaking or Exaggerated Shivering
  - Significant Muscle of Pain or Ache
  - Nausea or Vomiting
  - Diarrhea

Direct Exposure within 48 hours of someone **OUTSIDE** the household testing positive for COVID-19.

Direct Exposure within 48 hours of someone living **INSIDE** home that tests positive for COVID-19.

Student or Staff Member must self-isolate for **7-10 days** from LAST day of exposure.

Student or Staff Member must self-isolate for **17-20 days** from FIRST day of exposure.

- DIRECT EXPOSURE MEANS:**
- Been within 6 feet of someone diagnosed with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or without appropriate face protection (Mask or Gator)
  - FACE SHIELD AND MASKS WITH VENTS DO NOT PROTECT FROM EXPOSURE

May return after **7 days**, never developed COVID-19 symptoms and test negative for COVID-19 within 24 hours of returning to school.

OR

May return after **10 days**, and never developed COVID-19 related symptoms.

May return after **17 days**, never developed COVID-19 symptoms and test negative for COVID-19 within 24 hours of returning to school.

OR

May return after **20 days** and never developed COVID-19 related symptoms.
