



# Granbury ISD COVID-19 Symptom Flow Chart



Screen for COVID-19 Symptoms

- COVID SYMPTOMS**
- Fever greater than or equal to 100.0
  - Cough
  - Loss of Taste or Smell
  - Shortness of Breath
  - Difficulty Breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Headache
  - Chills
  - Sore Throat
  - Congestion or Runny Nose
  - Shaking or Exaggerated Shivering
  - Significant Muscle or Body Aches
  - Nausea or Vomiting
  - Diarrhea

**DIRECT EXPOSURE MEANS:**  
 An individual being within 3 feet for longer than 15 minutes of someone who is positive for COVID-19.

However, additional factors like case/contact masking (i.e., both the infectious individual and the potential close contact have been consistently and properly masked), ventilation, presence of dividers, vaccination status, prior infection status, and case of symptomology may affect this determination.

- No Symptoms
- No Diagnosis
- No Direct Exposure

**Can go to School**

Has 1 or more COVID symptom(s) **before** attending school.

Has 1 or more COVID symptom(s) **while** attending school.

Recommended Student or Staff Member get tested for COVID-19 at any GISD campus.

**POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST**

Student/Staff member can return after 10 days if fever free for 24 hours without taking fever reducing medications **AND** symptoms have improved.

**NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST**

May attend school if not running fever greater than 100.0, vomiting, or diarrhea within last 24 hours.

If symptoms exist, and student or staff member refuse to test, this will be treated as a positive test result and will follow the above protocol **OR** provide a doctor's note with alternate diagnosis.
