

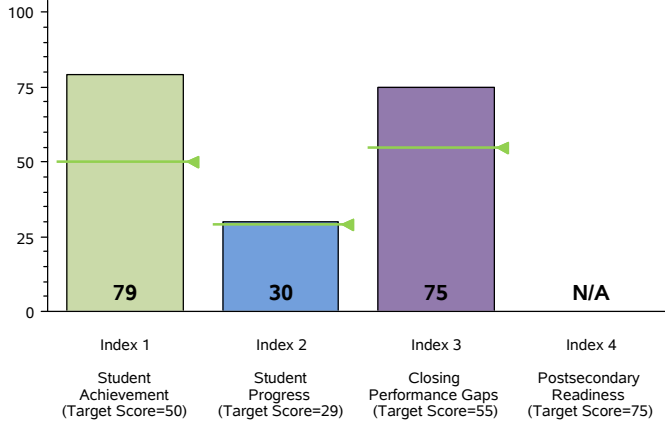

### 2013 Performance Index
