CSHAC Purpose/Board Policy:

These areas that should receive priority are: Nutrition Services, Health Service, Healthy and Safe School Environment, Counseling and Mental Health Services, Staff Wellness Promotion, Parent and Community Involvement, Physical Education, and Health Education. The Sub Committee for Physical Activity and Fitness Planning will be formed through the SHAC and will conduct the required meeting.

Naturally Slim Program-Wes Jones:

Granbury ISD is offering employees a program called Naturally Slim. Employees pay to join and if they finish the program the district will reimburse the money back. Promotes healthy lifestyle and diet choices to decrease absences.
