CSHAC Purpose/Board Policy:

It is necessary to coordinate school health which focuses on attention to different areas as the most effective and efficient way to meet the health needs of people. These areas that should receive priority are: Nutrition Services, Health Service, Healthy and Safe School Environment, Counseling and Mental Health Services, Staff Wellness Promotion, Parent and Community Involvement, Physical Education, and Health Education. The Sub Committee for Physical Activity and Fitness Planning will be formed through the SHAC and will conduct the required meeting.

Topics Discussed at SHAC:

- I. Sarah Thieroff from Cooks Children presented the Heart Safe School-Project Adam
 - Granbury ISD became a certified Heart Safe District using the Project ADAM program. This program creates awareness on the signs and symptoms of sudden cardiac death (SCD.)
 - Approved by committee, implemented and completed
- II. Archstone Dental Presentation:
 - Dental presentation came to Brawner Intermediate to discuss dental hygiene
- III. Dr. Watts presented EpiPen4schools program
 - The EpiPen4Schools[®] program helps improve access to epinephrine in the event a person experiences a life-threatening allergic reaction (anaphylaxis) in the school setting.
 - Approved by committee and recommended to school board, implemented for 2018-2019 school year
- IV. United Nations drug video reviewed by committee - pending committee approval

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Mindy Spruill presented a Human Trafficking Presentation - pending committee approval

GISD Nurse Updates:

- The Standing Orders for GISD for the 2017-2018 school year were presented to the SHAC; these orders were prepared by the nurses of GISD and approved by Dr. Shannon Watts
- The Immunization Report was filed on December 1, 2017
- Confirmed 3 Campylobacter cases, 1 Pertussis case, 1 Somenilla case, mump inquiries all negative
- Telemedicine-Cooks Children
 - 1) 15 visits
 - 2) 13 stayed in school, 3 went home (about 75% stayed in school)
 - 3) Sore throat (6) Ear pain (5), Rash (2), Conjunctivitis (1), URI (1), asthma (1)-numbers may not add up since one had 2 complaints (ear and throat)
 - 4) 7 strep tests (all negative)
 - 5) 1 flu test (negative)
- Growing up videos for 5th graders approved by committee
- Campus wide trainings on Hands Only CPR/Stop the Bleed/Active Shooter scheduled for 2017-2018 school year with Cooks Children, Texas EMS, and Granbury Sheriff Department
