Goal 1: We will develop and provide high-quality instruction and learning opportunities that support high rigor and engagement to ensure all students are prepared for post-secondary success.

- Increase ELA and MATH performance for all students.
- Maintain success in SCI and SOC ST.
- Increase CCMR accountability for GHS.
- 2021 Test Performance: ELA 1 71%; ELA 2: 60%; Alg 1: 66%; Bio: 88% and Social Studies: 92%
- 2022 Targets: ELA 1: 80%; ELA 2: 70%; Alg 1: 75%; Bio: 90% and Soc St: 95%
