**2021 - 2022 Campus Plan at a Glance**  
**Learning For All...Whatever It Takes!**

**Goal 1: We will develop and provide high-quality instruction and learning opportunities that support high rigor and engagement to ensure all students are prepared for post-secondary success.**

- **Increase campus rating from C (73) to B (80 or higher)**
  - Weekly PLCs led by teacher facilitators, Instructional Specialist, Principal, AP, Intervention Program Specialist
  - **Campus score improved to 75 on 2021 STAAR**
  - Interventions (LLI, RtI, MTA, Do The Math, Soluciones, campus tutors)
  - Guided Reading / Guided Math and Balanced Literacy
- **Earn at least one of six campus distinctions**
  - Use GISD approved curriculum resources
  - Target reading academic achievement in subpopulations
  - Data trackers for teachers and students
- **Increase At-Risk attendance rate**
  - Reward student academic gains during morning meeting
  - Field trips, Day of Service, spirit days on campus
  - Family Nights to promote positive school involvement

**Goal 2: We will commit to support student success by providing and retaining the appropriate quantity of qualified staff.**

- Daily common planning time (45 minutes)
- CLT will meet 4 times per year to review CIP and PD needs
- Instructional Specialist will assist all teachers with PD needs
- Mentoring for new staff members (meet once per six weeks)

**Goal 3: We will provide innovative opportunities to expose students to real-world environments engaging them into diverse partnerships fostering leadership.**

- Increase Brawner Day of Service community partners in March 2022.
- Increase the number of Career Day speakers in Feb. 2022.
  - Career Day and GISD Elementary Health Fair hosted by BRE
  - Partnership with GHS for Ready, Set, Teach students
  - Weekend snack packs provided by First Christian Church
  - Miler's Club, Growing Up video, P.S. It's My Body, health screenings

**Goal 4: We will engage students in all grade levels through participation in innovative and diverse activities to build character, leadership, and team-building skills.**

- **Students will participate in character and leadership activities such as Miler's Club, Restorative Practices, Boys Who Build, BLOOM, Peer Mediators, and Student Council. We will improve students who run 100 miles or more and reduce office referrals through the use of Restorative Practices; Principal's Advisory Committee will become a school-wide collaboration.**
  - FitnessGram, PE Showcase, and Scarecrow Scamper in PE

- Restorative practices taught through weekly kindness circles
- Daily morning meetings **in English / Spanish** that highlight student/staff achievement, campus motto, and kindness rules
- Students will donate to The Little Pantry, American Cancer Society, and Toys for Tots.

**Goal 5: We will maintain an optimal infrastructure that supports the appropriate number of devices to engage students in innovative, balanced, ethical, authentic learning opportunities and the training necessary to implement effectively.**

- **Increase the number of teachers using Google Classroom and SeeSaw .**
  - Weekly technology tips from Librarian provided for staff/students
  - Chromebooks, iPads will be used to enhance student academic performance
  - Students will input data on DMAC after CFAs and submit assignments in Google Classroom.

**Goal 6: We will evaluate and utilize facilities in innovative ways based on current needs and demographics to plan effectively for future growth to benefit all students.**

- Renovate facilities to safely open as a K-5 campus in August 2021 and serve over 750 students
- Collaborate with our Security Officer, Steven Fowler
- Regular campus safety drills to ensure safety procedures are followed
