STATEMENT TO PARENTS**

Compensatory Education Home Instruction is requested for the above named student. I agree to cooperate as follows:

1. Provide a place in the home that is quiet, free from distractions (away from other people and from TV), sanitary, well lighted, and properly ventilated and heated.
2. Provide a study table of suitable height. This table should be clean, properly lighted, and ready to be used when the teacher arrives.
3. Ensure the student is prepared for instruction when the teacher arrives. Please arrange other activities, including doctor appointments, around scheduled instruction. If problems arise with the homework, please contact the homebound teacher.
4. I understand that changes in the schedule may be necessary from time to time, as other students are added to or dropped from the rolls. As a result, I understand that schedules may have to be adjusted accordingly.
5. I shall see to it that an adult will always be in the home during the time the CEHI teacher is working with the student.
6. I shall notify the CEHI teacher before 8:30 a.m. if my child is ill and unable to have a lesson, or if he or anyone else in the home develops an infectious condition.
7. I understand that 90% of the work must be done by my child between the teacher's visits, and that she must be willing to work independently, and accept the responsibility of homework with the guidance of the CEHI teacher. I will see to it that my child has uninterrupted study time.
8. I understand that a student can be dropped from the CEHI program due to excessive unexcused absences, and I will do my best to keep my child's absences to a minimum.
9. It is my understanding that CEHI cannot begin until the above conditions have been met and that CEHI will have to be discontinued if these conditions are not maintained.
10. I also understand that the student's educational program will be planned and carried out on the basis of the limitations of the student and of the program of home instruction, which obviously cannot provide the experiences of a regular classroom.
11. Household pets should not be allowed to interrupt home instruction. If pets are usually kept indoors, they should be confined to a room other than the one in which class is being held.
